SENATE BILL NO. 59

BY SENATOR BUFFINGTON

Prefiled pursuant to Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(i) of the Constitution of Louisiana.

POSTSECONDARY ED. Requires the boards of supervisors for the Louisiana State University, Southern University, University of Louisiana and Louisiana Community and Technical College systems to broadcast the live audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge on the Internet. (1/1/14)

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:1455.1, 1831.1, 1853.1, and 1872.1, relative to university systems

3 management boards; to provide for live broadcasts over the Internet of meetings of

4 the boards and their committees; to provide for recording and archiving of such

5 broadcasts; to provide for public access to such archived meetings; to provide a

6 special effective date; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 17:1455.1, 1831.1, 1853.1, and 1872.1 are hereby enacted to read as

9 follows:

10 **§1455.1. Internet broadcast of board and committee meetings; archives**

11 **A. The board shall broadcast over the Internet live audio and video**

12 **streams of all its board and committee meetings held in Baton Rouge.**

13 **B. All meetings broadcast in accordance with Subsection A of this**

14 **Section shall be recorded, archived, and made accessible to the public for at**

15 **least one year after the date of the meeting.**

16 **C. The provisions of this Section shall apply to all meetings of the board**

17 **and its committees, but shall not apply to executive sessions held in accordance**

1 with the Louisiana Open Meetings Law as provided in R.S. 42:11 et seq.

2 D. The audio and video records created pursuant to this Section shall not
3 be construed in a manner to be the official record, or any part of the official
4 record, of the proceedings of a meeting of the board or any of its committees.

5 E. If the board is precluded from fulfilling the requirements of this
6 Section due to a technical problem beyond its control, or when the only meeting
7 room available lacks the equipment necessary to facilitate Internet broadcast,
8 the failure to broadcast or record the proceedings of a meeting of the board or
9 any of its committees shall not be construed to be a violation of the provisions
10 of this Section.

12 §1831.1. Internet broadcast of board and committee meetings; archives

13 A. The board of supervisors shall broadcast over the Internet live audio
14 and video streams of all its board and committee meetings held in Baton Rouge.

15 B. All meetings broadcast in accordance with Subsection A of this
16 Section shall be recorded, archived, and made accessible to the public for at
17 least one year after the date of the meeting.

18 C. The provisions of this Section shall apply to all meetings of the board

§1853.1. Internet broadcast of board and committee meetings; archives

A. The board shall broadcast over the Internet live audio and video streams of all its board and committee meetings held in Baton Rouge.

B. All meetings broadcast in accordance with Subsection A of this Section shall be recorded, archived, and made accessible to the public for at least one year after the date of the meeting.

§1872.1. Internet broadcast of board and committee meetings; archives
