PHARMACISTS: Defines compounded pharmacy-generated product

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 37:1164(57), relative to drug compounds; to define compounded pharmacy-
3 generated product; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 37:1164(57) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 §1164. Definitions

7 As used in this Chapter, the following terms have the meaning ascribed to
8 them by this Section:

9 * * *

10 (57) "Compounded pharmacy-generated product" means a drug product
11 prepared by a pharmacy for distribution, as defined by rule.

Abstract: Adds the definition of compounded pharmacy-generated product to the provisions regulating the practice of pharmacy.

Present law provides for the control and regulation of the practice of pharmacy, including the licensure of pharmacists and the licensure, permitting, certification, registration, control, and regulation of all persons or sites in or out of this state that sell drugs or devices to consumers or patients or assist in the practice of pharmacy within the state.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law provides for definitions relative to the practice of pharmacy.

Proposed law retains present law and adds the definition of "compounded pharmacy-generated product" as a drug product prepared by a pharmacy for distribution, as defined by rule.
