Provides relative to special funds in the state treasury. (8/1/13)

Proposed legislation creates the Fiscal Management Fund and provides that the source of monies shall include appropriations, donations, gifts, grants and any other monies as may be provided by law. Proposed legislation provides that monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state general fund and earnings are to be credited to the state general fund. Unexpended monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund. Monies in the fund shall be appropriated and expended to support fiscal initiatives as provided by law.

Effective upon governor's signature.

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EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

However, to the extent other legislative instruments create new statutory dedications, there may be material additional costs associated with the aggregate effort to administer these funds.
