Proposed bill creates the Balanced Budget Support Fund and provides that the source of monies shall include appropriations, donations, gifts, grants and any other monies as may be provided by law. Proposed legislation provides that monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state general fund and earnings are to be credited to the state general fund. Unexpended monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund. Monies in the fund shall be used or expended as provided by law.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure. Creating a new statutory dedication within the state treasury will result in a marginal additional workload for the agency, which can be absorbed with existing resources. However, to the extent other legislative instruments create new statutory dedications, there may be material additional costs associated with the aggregate effort to administer these funds.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure. The proposed legislation creates a new statutory dedicated fund within the state treasury but does not provide for a permanent revenue source to flow into the created fund.
