BRIDGES/FERRIES: Names a bridge located on U.S. 190 in Pointe Coupee Parish as the "Nickie Gene Voinche Memorial Bridge"

1 AN ACT

2 To name the bridge located on U.S. 190 in Pointe Coupee Parish as the "Nickie Gene
3 Voinche Memorial Bridge"; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. The bridge located on U.S. 190 in the town of Livonia of Pointe Coupee
6 Parish which connects Louisiana Highway 77 and Louisiana Highway 78 at their respective
7 intersections with U.S. 190 shall hereby be named the "Nickie Gene Voinche Memorial
8 Bridge".

9 Section 2. The Department of Transportation and Development or its contractors are
10 hereby directed to erect and maintain appropriate signage of this designation.
