8 through eighth grade, has been thriving for forty-one years and Mrs. Cahill still serves as
9 headmistress; her effectiveness in fostering the development and education of so many
10 children continues due to her dedication to the academy; and

11 WHEREAS, the school that began in Mrs. Cahill's living room and an original school
12 plan of one building on a two-acre site has grown to a twelve-acre site including classrooms,
13 library, dining room, and facilities for art, music, swimming, riding, and theater; and

14 WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Cahill have recently celebrated their fiftieth anniversary
15 and have five children and many grandchildren whom they love dearly; and

16 WHEREAS, Arden Cahill merits special commendation for her remarkable career
17 in education and her notable devotion and commitment to Arden Cahill Academy, its
18 students, and her family and friends.

19 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
20 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Arden Cahill for her many successes and
21 achievements during more than sixty years as an effective educator and does hereby extend
22 best wishes to Mrs. Cahill as she celebrates her memorable and historical achievements and
23 prepares for continued success in the future.
