5 On page 1, line 3, delete "headings for Parts III and III-A" and insert "heading for Part III-B"

7 On page 1, line 9, after "funds;" and before "and" insert "to provide for the collection,
8 deposit, and disbursement of sweet potato tax money; to provide for clarification of sweet
9 potato tax money collected each year; to provide for an effective date;"

1 AMENDMENT NO. 9 - **Adopted**

2 On page 8, after line 10, insert the following:

3 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
4 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
5 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
6 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
7 effective on the day following such approval."
