### A RESOLUTION

To recognize the contributions of veterans and their families, to commemorate the first annual Truce for the Troops Bowl on April 21, 2013, and to recognize Corey Webster as an Honorary Member of the Louisiana Democratic Caucus for this memorable occasion.
