

1 postsecondary credential in the most cost-effective manner possible; and

2 WHEREAS, a greater emphasis on institutional success in implementing effective
3 articulation and transfer policies in the postsecondary education funding formula would
4 provide an incentive for the state's public colleges and universities to increase their efforts
5 in this area.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
7 urge and request the Board of Regents to consider the efforts made by public postsecondary
8 educational institutions to effect successful articulation and transfer policies when allocating
9 funds through the postsecondary education funding formula.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to
11 chairman of the Board of Regents and the commissioner of higher education.
