COMMENDATIONS. Commends Sean Payton upon his return as the New Orleans Saints head coach.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To commend Patrick Sean Payton upon his return as the New Orleans Saints head coach.
3	WHEREAS, Patrick Sean Payton was born in San Mateo, California, raised in
4	Naperville, Illinois, by parents Thomas and Jeanne Payton, and has two children, daughter
5	Meghan and son Connor; and
6	WHEREAS, Sean Payton was a quarterback at Naperville Central High School, and,
7	after winning a scholarship, he successfully played quarterback at Eastern Illinois
8	University, leading the Panthers to an 11-2 record and the quarter finals of the Division I-AA
9	Playoffs in 1986, and was elected to the Eastern Illinois Hall of Fame in September 2000;
10	and
11	WHEREAS, although not drafted in 1987 into the National Football League (NFL),
12	he tried out for the Kansas City Chiefs for one day, and played quarterback for the Chicago
13	Bruisers and Pittsburgh Gladiators during the inaugural season of the Arena Football
14	League; and
15	WHEREAS, he was also a member of the Chicago Bears as one of the strikebreaking
16	replacement players, known as the "Spare Bears", during the 1987 NFL players strike where,
17	coincidently, his one interception came against the New Orleans Saints; and
18	WHEREAS, he began his coaching career as the offensive assistant coach for San

1	Diego State University and had several assistant coaching positions in the NFL, including
2	the quarterbacks coach for the Philadelphia Eagles, assistant coach for the New York Giants,
3	and assistant coach for the Dallas Cowboys before being named as the tenth coach in Saints
4	history; and
5	WHEREAS, in the wake of Hurricane Katrina, the Saints finished the 2005 season
6	with a disappointing 3-13 record, but in 2006, Coach Payton joined the franchise as head
7	coach and aggressively worked and motivated the team to a winning 10-6 record and their
8	first playoff appearance in six years; and
9	WHEREAS, in recognition of his team's dramatic improvement and inspirational
10	play, Coach Payton was selected as the 2006 Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year; and
11	WHEREAS, in 2009, he aggressively coached the Saints to their most successful
12	season, with a 13-3 regular season record and a 31-17 victory over the Indianapolis Colts in
13	the Super Bowl XLIV - the first professional football championship for the city of New
14	Orleans, the state of Louisiana, and the Saints franchise; and
15	WHEREAS, in 2010, Coach Payton led the Saints to an 11-5 record and their second
16	consecutive post-season appearance, becoming only the second coach in franchise history
17	to post three double-digit winning seasons; and
18	WHEREAS, Coach Payton followed-up in 2011, leading the Saints to another 13-3
19	record, their third consecutive post-season appearance, and the fourth post-season
20	appearance in his six years with the franchise; and
21	WHEREAS, during the 2009, 2010, and 2011 seasons, coached by Sean Payton, the
22	Saints won 41 regular-season and playoff games combined, more than any other team in the
23	NFL; and
24	WHEREAS, in January 2013, Coach Payton, who guided the most successful period
25	in Saints franchise history, signed a five-year contract extension as head coach at a time
26	when most experts would agree that he would have become the most coveted available coach
27	in the NFL if allowed to become a free agent; and
28	WHEREAS, it brings great joy and hope to the numerous fans and supporters of
29	Saints football to know that when the season starts in the fall of 2013, Coach Payton will
30	once again be on the sidelines leading and inspiring the players and coaches; and
