

1 WHEREAS, the Legislature of Louisiana would like an update on the status of the
2 creation and distribution of such attestation forms to employing agencies in compliance with
3 Act No. 479 of the 2012 Regular Session of the Legislature.

4 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
5 urge and request each state and statewide retirement system, plan, or fund to report by May
6 20, 2013, to the House Committee on Retirement and the Senate Committee on Retirement
7 on the status of their efforts regarding the creation and distribution of attestation forms
8 pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 479 of the 2012 Regular Session of the Legislature.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each state and statewide retirement system, plan,
10 or fund shall appear before the House and Senate committees on retirement, when requested
11 by the chairmen thereof, to update the committees on the status and progress of
12 implementing the provisions of Act No. 479 of the 2012 Regular Session of the Legislature.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
14 to each state and statewide retirement system.

Present law, Act No. 479 of the 2012 R.S., provides for the forfeiture of retirement benefits by public employees convicted of certain felonies. Requires public retirement systems to create and distribute forms explaining the forfeiture law.

The resolution requests each state and statewide retirement system, plan, or fund to report, by May 20, 2013, to the House Committee on Retirement and the Senate Committee on Retirement on the status of efforts regarding the creation and distribution of attestation forms pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 479 of the 2012 R.S.

Further requests that each state and statewide retirement system, plan, or fund appear before the House and Senate committees on retirement to update the committees on the status and progress of implementing the provisions of the Act.
