

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 114 by Senator Martiny

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after R.S. 28:53.3" and before the comma "," insert "and 67(4)"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 4, after "video;" and before "and" insert "to authorize certain persons with
5 concurrence of the coroner to petition the court for an order authorizing involuntary
6 outpatient treatment of certain patients;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 17 in their entirety and on page 2, at the beginning of line
9 1, delete "Isle." and insert the following:

10 "When a peace officer or other credible person executes a statement
11 made to the best of his knowledge, belief, and personal observations from any
12 law enforcement agency physically located in the city of Kenner or the towns of
13 Jean Lafitte or Grand Isle pursuant to R.S. 28:53.2, the statement may be made
14 by video conference between the peace officer or other credible person and the
15 Jefferson Parish coroner's office."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 4

17 On page 2, at the end of line 1, delete "fill out" and insert "complete"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 5

19 On page 2, line 3, after "appropriate" and before the period "." delete "police station" and
20 insert "law enforcement agency"

21 AMENDMENT NO. 6

22 On page 2, line 6, after "office" and before the period "." insert "for the coroner's
23 signature"

24 AMENDMENT NO. 7

25 On page 2, after line 7, add a set of asterisks and the following:

26 "§67. Petition to the court

27 A petition for an order authorizing involuntary outpatient treatment may be
28 filed in the judicial district in the parish in which the patient is present or reasonably
29 believed to be present. A petition to obtain an order authorizing involuntary
30 outpatient treatment may be initiated by one of the following persons:

32 (4) Any interested person through counsel with written concurrence of
33 the coroner in the jurisdiction in which the person is found."
