4	WHEREAS, LSU AgCenter 4-H program participants gain knowledge and life skills
5	enabling them to become positive, productive, and compassionate members of their
6	communities; and
7	WHEREAS, 4-H has three primary program initiatives: citizenship, healthy living,
8	and science, engineering, and technology; and
9	WHEREAS, 4-H youth learn leadership and life skills through a variety of projects
10	on topics such as outdoor skills, aerospace, animal science, nutrition, forestry, and
11	community service; and
12	WHEREAS, "Learning by Doing" is the 4-H club slogan which encourages members
13	to develop and improve their critical thinking and communication skills; and
14	WHEREAS, the Louisiana 4-H Youth Development program continues to expand
15	to meet the needs of youth, with participation exceeding two hundred forty thousand
16	members across the state; and
17	WHEREAS, through its extraordinary record of research, education, youth
