9 In order to place the restrictions and limitations of Article III, Section
10 2(A)(4)(b) of the Constitution of Louisiana into the rules, procedures, and practices
11 of the Senate and the House of Representatives and to provide guidance to the
12 members of the legislature through the application of Louisiana case law as well as
13 the logical extrapolations which arise from such case law, the legislature does adopt
14 this Joint Rule, as follows:

15 A. During any regular session convening in an odd-numbered year, no matter
16 intended to have the effect of law, including any suspension of law, shall be
17 introduced, considered, or adopted unless it meets one of the following criteria:

18 * * *
19 (3)(a) Its object is not within the subject matter restrictions provided in
20 Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(introductory paragraph) of the Constitution of
21 Louisiana or within the exception provided by Article III, Section 2(A)(4)(b)(ii) of
22 the Constitution of Louisiana, but it is prefiled no later than the deadline provided
23 in Article III, Section 2(A) of the Constitution of Louisiana, provided that a member
24 shall not prefile more than five such matters.

25 (b) Bills or resolutions which may be considered pursuant to this
26 Subparagraph, including those which have applicability in a particular locale but
27 which are not required to be advertised as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the
28 Constitution of Louisiana which shall be considered only pursuant to this
29 Subparagraph, shall include but shall not be limited to:

30 * * *
31 (x) The resolution to approve the formula to fund the Minimum Foundation
32 Program.

34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Legislature of Louisiana that Joint
35 Rule No. 20(A)(1)(b)(iii) of the Joint Rules of the Senate and House of
36 Representatives is hereby repealed in its entirety.

37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Legislature of Louisiana that this
38 concurrent resolution shall become effective on June 7, 2013."
