- 13 investments which the business intends to claim for purposes of the tax credit, as
- well as any documents or other materials required by the office relative to the pre-14 15
- clearance process. The office shall by rule establish requirements for application for 16 and approval of pre-clearance status. Each tax year, the authority for the office to
- grant pre-clearance status to emergency preparedness plans shall be limited to that 17
- number of plans containing estimated qualified expenses and investments which, in 18 19
- the aggregate, would generate no more than one million dollars in tax credits.
- 20 (2) To claim a tax credit, in addition to any other documentation the
- 21 Department of Revenue may require, a business shall also submit to the department
- evidence of the pre-clearance status of its emergency preparedness plan. 22
