EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Implementation of the proposed legislation will result in an indeterminable one-time expenditure in fees and self-generated revenues within the Secretary of State's Office. The anticipated expenditures will provide for a contractor to perform programming changes to the Commercial Program's corporations database, application and web pages. The agency estimates approximately 8,000 hours of programming at \$100 per hour will be required, or \$800,000.

The Legislative Fiscal Office is unable to corroborate the estimated 8,000 hours of programming costs as a result of the proposed legislation. However, the LFO is working with the Secretary of State to determine if the anticipated 8,000 hours of contractor costs is a reasonable expenditure expectation of this bill.

The legislation provides for enactment of an updated or modern business corporations act, that is based on recommendations from the Louisiana Law Institute.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure as the proposed legislation does not modify any fees collected by the Secretary of State in current statutes.
