- 5 "WHEREAS, water hyacinth, a South American native, was first introduced to the United States as an ornamental plant at the World's Industrial and Cotton 6 Centennial Exposition in New Orleans in 1884 and frequently clogs bayous and canals, impedes boat traffic, slows water currents, and blocks light to native 8 9 submerged aquatic vegetation, degrading water quality and harming wildlife; and WHEREAS, hydrilla, originally from Asia, is a rooted, aquatic weed that 10 inhabits both deep and shallow waters forming thick mats that impede boat traffic 11 and swimming and adversely affects water quality by shading out native vegetation, 12 lowering dissolved oxygen concentrations, and can result in fish kills." 13
