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| 2 | To enact R.S. 36:409(C)(6) and Part II-C of Chapter 7 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised |
| 3 | Statutes of 1950, to be comprised of R.S. 40:1558.1 through 1558.7, relative to |
| 4 | volunteer firefighters; to create the Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement |
| 5 | Fund; to provide for the creation of the Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition |
| 6 | Reimbursement Board within the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and |
| 7 | to provide for the board's membership; to provide for definitions; to provide for |
| 8 | eligibility of applicants; to provide for rules and regulations; and to provide for |
| 9 | related matters. |
| 10 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: |
| 11 | Section 1. R.S. 36:409(C)(6) is hereby enacted to read as follows: |
| 12 | §409. Transfer of agencies to Department of Public Safety and Corrections |
| 13 | * * * |
| 14 | C. The following agencies, as defined by R.S. 36:3, are transferred to and |
| 15 | hereafter shall be within the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, as |
| 16 | provided in R.S. 36:802: |
| 17 | * * * |
| 18 | (6) The Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement Board (R.S. |
| 19 | 40:1558.1 et seq.) |
| 20 | * * * |
| 21 | Section 2. Part II-C of Chapter 7 of Title 40 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of |
| 22 | 1950, comprised of R.S. 40:1558.1 through 1558.7, is hereby enacted to read as follows: |

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| 1 | PART II-C. VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS' TUITION REIMBURSEMENT FUND |
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| 2 | <u>§1558.1. Purpose</u> |
| 3 | A. The legislature finds and declares that volunteer fire departments make |
| 4 | up the vast majority of fire departments in the state, and the number of volunteers is |
| 5 | declining. Participation in volunteer fire departments is vital to public safety; |
| 6 | therefore, it is crucial to the future of emergency services in this state to encourage |
| 7 | participation in volunteer fire departments. |
| 8 | B. It is the purpose of this Part to provide for the creation of the Volunteer |
| 9 | Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement Fund, wherein the state may financially |
| 10 | reimburse eligible students who volunteer with volunteer fire departments. |
| 11 | §1558.2. Definitions |
| 12 | As used in this Part, the following words shall have the following meanings: |
| 13 | (1) "Board" means the Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement |
| 14 | Board. |
| 15 | (2) "Combination fire department" means a department whose personnel is |
| 16 | composed of both volunteer and professional firefighters. |
| 17 | (3) "Recipient" means a person who has met the eligibility requirements and |
| 18 | is awarded tuition reimbursement from the Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition |
| 19 | Reimbursement Fund. |
| 20 | §1558.3. Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement Fund |
| 21 | A. There is hereby established a special fund in the state treasury to be |
| 22 | known as the Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement Fund, hereinafter |
| 23 | referred to as the "fund", which shall consist of monies appropriated annually by the |
| 24 | legislature for the purpose set forth in this Part to the extent that state general funds |
| 25 | are available; federal funds; public or private donations, gifts, or grants from |
| 26 | individuals, corporations, nonprofit organizations, or other business entities which |
| 27 | may be made to the fund; and any other monies that may be provided by law. |
| 28 | B.(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, after |
| 29 | compliance with the requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B) of the Constitution of |
| 30 | Louisiana relative to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund, and after a sufficient |

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| 1 | amount is allocated from the Bond Security and Redemption Fund to pay all of the |
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| 2 | obligations secured by the full faith and credit of the state that become due and |
| 3 | payable within any fiscal year, the treasurer shall pay into the Volunteer Firefighters' |
| 4 | Tuition Reimbursement Fund an amount equal to the amount provided for in |
| 5 | Subsection A of this Section. |
| 6 | (2) Monies appropriated from the fund shall be used solely as provided by |
| 7 | Subsection C of this Section and only in the amounts appropriated by the legislature. |
| 8 | All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year |
| 9 | shall remain in the fund. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the state |
| 10 | treasurer in the same manner as monies in the state general fund, and interest earned |
| 11 | on the investment of these monies shall be credited to the fund following compliance |
| 12 | with the requirements of Article VII, Section 9(B) relative to the Bond Security and |
| 13 | Redemption Fund. |
| 14 | C. Subject to annual appropriation by the legislature, the monies in the |
| 15 | Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement Fund shall be used solely for |
| 16 | providing tuition reimbursement to eligible volunteer firefighters attending a state |
| 17 | funded public college, university, or vocational or technical school. |
| 18 | D. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, no monies from the |
| 19 | state general fund (direct) shall be deposited or appropriated to the fund unless and |
| 20 | until two-thirds of the elected members of each house of the legislature consent to |
| 21 | such deposit or appropriation. |
| 22 | §1558.4. Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement Board; creation; |
| 23 | <u>membership</u> |
| 24 | A. There is hereby created the Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement |
| 25 | Board within the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, office of state fire |
| 26 | marshal. |
| 27 | B. The Volunteer Firefighters' Tuition Reimbursement Board shall be |
| 28 | composed of seven members as follows: |
| 29 | (1) The state fire marshal or his designee. |
| 30 | (2) The president of the Senate or his designee. |

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| 1 | (3) The speaker of the House of Representatives or his designee. |
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| 2 | (4) One member appointed by the governor. |
| 3 | (5) One member appointed by the Louisiana State Firemen's Association. |
| 4 | (6) Two members appointed by the Louisiana Fire Chiefs Association, one |
| 5 | of whom shall be the chief of a predominantly volunteer fire department. |
| 6 | C. Each board member shall serve without compensation. |
| 7 | D. The board shall adopt rules and regulations providing for the governance |
| 8 | of the board, including but not limited to the following: |
| 9 | (1) Procedures for the election of board officers and terms of office. |
| 10 | (2) Methods and grounds for removal of board members, which shall include |
| 11 | but not be limited to conviction of a felony and failure to meet attendance rules. |
| 12 | (3) Procedures for filling vacancies created by removal, resignation, or death |
| 13 | of any member prior to the end of the member's term, which shall follow those used |
| 14 | for the initial appointment of members to the board. |
| 15 | E. Four members shall constitute a quorum and shall be required to conduct |
| 16 | the business of the board. A majority vote of the members constituting a quorum |
| 17 | shall be necessary for any action taken by the board. |
| 18 | §1558.5. Powers and duties of the board |
| 19 | A. The board shall: |
| 20 | (1) Create an application and develop application procedures. |
| 21 | (2) Determine which applications meet the eligibility requirements provided |
| 22 | for in R.S. 40:1558.6 and any rules or regulations promulgated by the board. |
| 23 | (3) Disburse to recipients an amount equal to the tuition charged by the state |
| 24 | <u>funded college</u> , <u>university</u> , <u>or vocational or technical school selected by the recipient</u> . |
| 25 | (4) Require the fire chiefs of recipients to file voluntary status affidavits |
| 26 | with the board for each semester for each recipient. |
| 27 | (5) Require recipients to file education progress reports with the board after |
| 28 | each semester. |
| 29 | B. The board shall determine recipients based on eligible applicants in the |
| 30 | order in which the applications were received by the board. |
