

Prior law provided no person shall undertake, offer to undertake, or agree to perform home improvement contracting services unless registered with and approved by the Residential Building Contractors Subcommittee (subcommittee) of the State Licensing Board for Contractors (board) as a home improvement contractor.

Prior law provided for a list of exceptions to the registration requirement, one of which is an exception for a homeowner who physically performs home improvement work on his personal residence.

New law retains these provisions but expands the exception to a person who physically performs home improvement work on other property owned by him when the work has a value of less than \$7,500.

Effective August 1, 2013.
