COMMENDATIONS. Commends Dr. Benjamin Sachs, dean of the School of Medicine, for his leadership and activities at Tulane University School of Medicine.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To commend Dr. Benjamin Sachs for his tremendous contribution to education and
3	leadership at Tulane University School of Medicine and for his service as dean of the
4	School of Medicine.
5	WHEREAS, as a native of London and the son of Holocaust survivors, Dr. Benjamin
6	Sachs graduated from St. Mary's Hospital Medical School in London, now Imperial College,
7	London and earned a degree in public health at the University of Toronto; and
8	WHEREAS, prior to moving to New Orleans, Dr. Sachs served as professor of
9	obstetrics and gynecology at Harvard Medical School for twenty-nine years and chairman
10	of obstetrics and gynecology at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston,
11	Massachusetts; and
12	WHEREAS, in an interview Dr. Sachs, stated that the prospect of helping Tulane and
13	the city of New Orleans rebuild after hurricanes Katrina and Rita had been a major factor in
14	persuading him to accept the position as dean of the School of Medicine in November, 2007;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, during his tenure at Tulane, Dean Sachs recruited nineteen new leaders,
17	including ten department heads while applications to the medical school have increased by
18	forty-seven percent and the entrance examination scores for students entering the medical

1	school have increased significantly, and federally funded research has increased by fifteen
2	percent; and
3	WHEREAS, Dean Sachs is a true humanitarian, showing compassion for his fellow
4	man and the underprivileged, has helped launch a network of clinics delivering primary and
5	preventative care to people in some of Boston's poorest neighborhoods and continued to
6	assist the delivery of care in New Orleans in conjunction with Dr. Karen DeSalvo at Tulane
7	University; and
8	WHEREAS, this service network of clinics gained national attention garnering
9	support for funding and collaboration from Johnson & Johnson, Qatar, LSU, the Daughters
10	of Charity, Xavier University, Loyola University, Delgado Community College's Charity
11	School of Nursing, and the federal government; and
12	WHEREAS, by 2010 this network of clinics was treating over 200,000 people every
13	year; and
14	WHEREAS, in honor of the clinic's achievement, Tulane's medical school received
15	the Spencer Foreman Award, one of the highest honors bestowed by the Association of
16	American Medical Colleges, which represents 150 medical schools in the United States and
17	Canada; and
18	WHEREAS, Dean Sachs has been a real champion for helping leaders in the
19	community recognize the value of primary medical care to the underprivileged and the entire
20	community.
21	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
22	does hereby commend Dr. Benjamin Sachs, dean of the Tulane University School of
23	Medicine, for his tremendous contribution to the practice of medicine, medical education,
24	Tulane University and the state of Louisiana.
