APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "Brian Gerald v. State of Louisiana DOTD"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2014-
3 2015 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Brian Gerald v.
4 State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and Development";
5 and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand and No/100
8 (\$197,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of
9 Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2014-2015 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit
10 entitled "Brian Gerald v. State of Louisiana, through the Department of Transportation and
11 Development", bearing Number 77640 "A" on the docket of the Sixteenth Judicial District
12 Court, parish of St. Martin, state of Louisiana.

13 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2014; if vetoed by the governor
14 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
15 2014, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
