HOUSE BILL NO. 344

BY REPRESENTATIVE ARMES

WILDLIFE & FISHERIES: Provides relative to fees for hunting and fishing licenses paid by surviving spouses of members of the military killed in action

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 56:104(B)(3) and 302.2(D), relative to fees for hunting and fishing licenses;
3 to provide relative to fees to be paid by surviving spouses of members of certain
4 military service branches killed in action; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 56:104(B)(3) and 302.2(D) are hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §104. License fees; reciprocity; exceptions

11 (3) Any resident of Louisiana who is the surviving spouse of a member of
12 the United States Armed Forces, the Louisiana Army National Guard, or the
13 Louisiana Air National Guard who was killed in action, upon showing identification
14 and documentation satisfactory to the department, shall be issued all hunting licenses
15 and permits for a total fee of two dollars and fifty cents.

17 §302.2. Exception for certain residents, nonresidents, and military personnel from
18 purchase or possession of basic recreational and saltwater license

1 D. Any resident of Louisiana who is the surviving spouse of a member of the
2 United States Armed Forces, the Louisiana Army National Guard, or the Louisiana
3 Air National Guard who was killed in action, upon showing identification and
4 documentation satisfactory to the department, shall be issued recreational and
5 saltwater fishing licenses for a total fee of two dollars and fifty cents.

Armes HB No. 344

Abstract: Provides for reduced fee hunting and fishing licenses for surviving spouses of members of the U. S. military killed in action.

Present law requires the payment of fees for the issuance of hunting and fishing licenses. Provides for certain exemptions from those fees.

Proposed law provides that any resident of La. who is the surviving spouse of a member of the U.S. Armed Forces, the La. Army National Guard, or the La. Air National Guard who was killed in action shall be issued all hunting licenses and permits for a total fee of \$2.50 and recreational and saltwater fishing licenses for a total fee of \$2.50.
