6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:24.4(E) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
8	§24.4. Louisiana Competency-Based Education Program; statewide standards for
9	required subjects; Louisiana Educational Assessment Program; parish or city
10	school board comprehensive pupil progression plans; waivers
11	* * *
12	E. The state Department of Education shall <u>develop</u> , with the approval of the
13	State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, as part of the Louisiana
14	Competency-Based Education Program, develop and establish statewide content
15	standards for required subjects to be taught in the public elementary and secondary
16	schools of this state. Prior to implementation, such standards shall be promulgated
17	in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act. The statewide content
18	standards for required subjects shall be implemented by the state Department of
19	Education as approved by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education,

Abstract: Requires that the state content standards developed by the state Dept. of Education be promulgated in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the La. Competency-Based Education Program, including the development and implementation of statewide standards for required subjects and the La. Educational Assessment Program (LEAP). Requires the state Dept. of Education to develop, with the approval of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, statewide content standards for required subjects for public elementary and secondary schools. Requires implementation of the standards by the department, with recommendations prior to approval and advice from the educational personnel in the public schools and colleges and universities of this state.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds requirement that the department promulgate the standards in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act (APA). <u>Present law</u> (R.S. 49:950 et seq.), the APA, provides for public notice and public hearings regarding agency rules.
