5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 40:1379.1(G) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1379.1. Special officers; powers and duties; concealed handgun permit; railroad
8	police officer

10	G. Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsections B and J of this Section, a
11	special officer commission issued to a railroad police officer commissioned pursuant
12	to 49 U.S.C. 28101, shall remain effective at all times during his employment unless
13	otherwise revoked.
