**Abstract:** Requires the Department of Children and Family Services to respond to discovery requests in certain actions they have initiated to obtain certain orders relative to child support obligations.

CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the Dept. of Children and Family Services to develop and implement a program of family support, including obtaining and modifying family and child support orders.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and requires the department to respond to requests for discovery in actions the department has initiated pursuant to the family and child support program.
