Authorizes an increase in court costs in the mayor's court of the town of Rosepine. (2/3 - CA7s2.1) (8/1/14)

Purpose of Bill: This measure authorizes the Mayor of the Town of Rosepine to impose an additional court cost not to exceed \$30 for each offense.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

However, an official with the Town of Rosepine indicated that the revenue generated by this bill will be spent on police officers as follows: 80% for equipment, 12% for training, and 8% for salaries.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The bill may increase local governmental revenues for the Town of Rosepine by approximately \$37,500 annually.

An official with the Town of Rosepine stated that there are approximately 1,300 tickets written each year. The 1,300 tickets at an additional cost of \$30 per ticket, less \$1,500 in dismissed tickets, would yield an additional \$37,500 in revenue.
