MOTOR CARRIERS: Provides for the registration expiration date for certain commercial trucks and trailers

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 47:508(A)(3), relative to the registration of certain commercial vehicles and
3 trailers; to establish the expiration date and renewal period for the registration of
4 certain vehicles and trailers; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 47:508(A)(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §508. Registration; commercial vehicles; exemption

8 A.

9 * * *

10 (3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, every
11 registration of a truck in excess of ten thousand pounds or trailer licensed pursuant
12 to R.S. 47:462 shall expire one year from the date of issuance and thereafter shall be
13 renewed annually.

Abstract: Provides for the expiration date and renewal period for the registration of certain commercial trucks and trailers.

Proposed law provides that the expiration of the registration is one year from the date of issuance for trucks in excess of 10,000 pounds or trailers licensed pursuant to R.S. 47:462 and thereafter requires annual renewals.
