DIGEST

Buffington (SB 427)

<u>Present law</u> provides that, in addition to all other applicable fees and costs, the LSBME shall charge a \$25 fee at the time of issuance, renewal, or reinstatement of a physician license, certificate, permit, or registration.

<u>Present law</u> provides that this fee shall be utilized for the identification, monitoring, assistance, and procurement of treatment of physicians suffering from any of the following:

- (1) Substance abuse.
- (2) Chemical dependency.
- (3) Psychiatric conditions.
- (4) Physical deficiencies which may interfere with the physician's ability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety.

Proposed law increases the fee from \$25 to \$50.

Effective August 1, 2014.
