Provides the following diseases/conditions shall be reported to the Department of Health and Hospitals (DHH), office of public health, by the end of the workweek after the existence of a case, suspected case, or a positive laboratory result is known:

- (1) Cancer.
- (2) Monoxide exposure and/or poisoning.
- (3) Complications of abortion.
- (4) Congenital hypothyroidism.
- (5) Galactosemia.
- (6) Heavy metal (arsenic, cadmium, mercury) exposure and/or poisoning (All Ages).
- (7) Hemophilia.
- (8) Lead exposure and/or poisoning (children); (adults).
- (9) Pesticide-related illness or injury (all ages).
- (10) Phenylketonuria.
- (11) Reye's Syndrome.
- (12) Severe traumatic head injury.
- (13) Severe under nutrition (severe anemia, failure to thrive).
- (14) Sickle cell disease (newborns).
- (15) Spinal cord injury.
- (16) Sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS).

Adds Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) to the list of diseases/conditions that shall be reported to DHH.
