AN ACT

To enact R.S. 40:4.15, relative to the state Sanitary Code; to provide an exception regarding drinking fountains at certain places of business; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 40:4.15 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§4.15. Drinking fountain exception
Notwithstanding any provision of the state Sanitary Code or any other provision of law or regulation to the contrary, a drinking fountain shall not be required in certain places of business.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.
