HB No. 97

Abstract: Provides relative to a sales and use tax for the Union Parish School Board.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the school board of any school district comprised of a parish having a population between 22,400 and 22,800 is authorized to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax not to exceed one percent within the territorial jurisdiction of the parish.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that the authority granted by <u>present law</u> to levy and collect an additional sales and use tax is granted solely to the Union Parish School Board; otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
