**Abstract:** Provides for the expiration date and renewal period for the registration of certain commercial trucks and trailers.

Proposed law provides that the expiration of the registration is one year from the date of issuance for trucks in excess of 10,000 pounds or trailers licensed pursuant to present law and thereafter requires annual renewals. Exempts semitrailers and trailers with permanent registrations and license plates from the annual renewal requirement.

### Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to the original bill.

1. Added an exemption to annual renewals for semitrailers and trailers that have permanent registrations and license plates.
