Provides relative to hospital notaries.(8/1/14)

Present law provides that the director of a hospital services district may appoint not more than two employees of the hospital as ex officio notaries public. Present law provides that such ex officio notaries may exercise the functions of a notary public only to perform certain notary tasks and activities. Proposed law expands and amends language to make the capacity of hospital directors to appoint an ex officio notary public to include those hospital services districts not included in the referenced statute. Proposed law provides that ex officio notaries appointed under this statutory authority may only exercise notary tasks and activities limited to matters within the official business functions of the hospital.
