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PUBLIC CONTRACTS OR NO IMPACT See Note Page 1 of 1 Establishes protections for certain independent public contractors who report criminal activity on the part of public entities

Proposed bill provides that a contractor shall be free from reprisal by the contracting public entity if he reports in good faith and upon reasonable suspicion information he believes indicates criminal activity on the part of the contracting public entity. Proposed bill applies to contracts of any agency, board, bureau, committee, council, court, department, district governing authority, government corporation, institution, task force or other entity of the state or any political subdivision of the state.
