A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2	To recognize Wednesday, April 16, 2014, as the National Multiple Sclerosis Society Public
3	Policy Conference Day at the state capitol and to encourage efforts to inform
4	Louisianians about multiple sclerosis.
5	WHEREAS, multiple sclerosis (MS) is a lifelong, unpredictable, and often disabling
6	disease of the central nervous system; and
7	WHEREAS, MS affects an estimated 2.5 million people worldwide, three-quarters
8	of whom are women, and most people are diagnosed during the prime-of-life years, ages
9	twenty through fifty; and
10	WHEREAS, a community of Louisianians, along with the National Multiple
11	Sclerosis Society, are committed to doing something about MS now; they support programs
12	and services to enhance the lives of people affected by MS, raise funds and awareness
13	through Bike MS and Walk MS events, and invest in research toward a cure for the disease;

15	WHEREAS, today is the day of the National Multiple Sclerosis 2014 Louisiana
16	Public Policy Conference, a gathering of MS activists committed to creating positive change
17	through advocacy for Louisianians affected by MS and other chronic conditions; and
18	WHEREAS, though much still remains to be done, the work of the National Multiple
19	Sclerosis Society and other organizations working on behalf of those with MS is helping to
20	create a dynamic movement with the ultimate goal of achieving a world free of MS.
