Provides for a contradictory hearing on the discharge of conditions of probation and on the termination of a defendant's suspended sentence or probation

Present law (C.Cr.P. Art. 896) authorizes the court to modify, change, or discharge the conditions of a defendant's probation, or to add further conditions. Proposed law retains present law but provides that the court may only discharge conditions of probation after a contradictory hearing, which may be waived by the state.

Present law (C.Cr.P. Art. 897) authorizes the court to terminate the defendant's probation or suspended sentence at any time in misdemeanor cases and after one year of probation in felony cases. Proposed law retains present law but provides that the court may only terminate the defendant's probation or suspended sentence and discharge the defendant after a contradictory hearing, which may be waived the state.
