MTR VEHICLE/OFFICE: Provides for a reduced convenience fee for mobility impaired persons at public license tag agents

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact R.S. 47:532.1(C), relative to public license tax agents; to provide a
3	reduced convenience fee for mobility impaired persons at public license tag agents;
4	to provide for the definition of mobility impaired; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 47:532.1(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§532.1. Public license tag agents; auto title companies; rules and regulations; surety
8	bonds; fees
9	* * *
10	C. (1) Public license tag agents shall be authorized to collect a convenience
11	fee in addition to the registration license tax. The convenience fee shall not exceed
12	eighteen dollars per license. However, the public license tag agents shall collect and
13	retain the full amount of the convenience fee. The seller is authorized to charge the
14	convenience fee authorized by this Subsection in connection with any retail sale, in
15	addition to the fees authorized in Chapter 10-B of Title 6 of the Louisiana Revised
16	Statutes of 1950.
17	(2) The convenience fee for those persons who are mobility impaired shall
18	not exceed nine dollars per license. For purposes of this Section, the term "mobility
19	impaired person" includes any person who is impaired because of any of the
20	following conditions:

1	(a) Unable to walk two hundred feet without stopping to rest.
2	(b) Unable to walk without the assistance of another person, walker, cane,
3	crutches, braces, prosthetic device, or wheelchair, including individuals who are
4	blind or have such a visual impairment that the assistance of another person is
5	necessary to walk.
6	(c) Restricted by a lung disease to such an extent that the person's forced
7	expiratory volume for one second is less than one liter, or the arterial oxygen tension
8	is less than sixty mm/hg on room air at rest.
9	(d) Uses portable oxygen.
10	(e) A cardiac condition to the extent that the person's functional limitations
11	are classified in severity as Class III or Class IV according to standards set by the
12	American Heart Association.
13	(f) A diagnosed disease or disorder, including a severe arthritic, neurological,
14	or orthopedic impairment, which creates a severe mobility limitation.

Abstract: Provides for a reduced convenience fee for mobility impaired persons at public license tag agents.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the convenience fee charged by public license tag agents shall not exceed \$9 for those persons who are mobility impaired.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "mobility impaired person" as a person impaired by any of the following conditions:

- (1) Unable to walk 200 feet without stopping to rest.
- (2) Unable to walk without the assistance of another person, walker, cane, crutches, braces, prosthetic device, or wheelchair, including individuals who are blind or so visually impaired that the assistance of another person is necessary to walk.
- (3) Restricted by a lung disease to such an extent that the person's forced expiratory volume for one second is less than one liter, or the arterial oxygen tension is less than 60 mm/hg on room air at rest.

- (4) Uses portable oxygen.
- (5) A cardiac condition to the extent that the person's functional limitations are classified in severity as Class III or Class IV according to standards set by the American Heart Association.
- (6) A diagnosed disease or disorder, including a severe arthritic, neurological, or orthopedic impairment, which creates a severe mobility limitation.
