HUNTERS/HUNTING. Allows for the hunting of outlaw quadrupeds from a helicopter.

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 56:116.1(D)(4), relative to the taking of wild quadrupeds; to allow the taking
3 of certain outlaw quadrupeds during daylight hours from a helicopter; to provide
4 notification requirements; to provide terms, conditions, and requirements; and to
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 56:116.1(D)(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §116.1. Wild birds and wild quadrupeds; times and methods of taking; penalties

10 D.(1) * * *

12 **(4) On private property, the landowner, or his lessee or agent with**
13 **written permission and the landowner's contact information in his possession,**
14 **may take outlaw quadrupeds from a helicopter during daylight hours any time**
15 **of year. Any person attempting to take outlaw quadrupeds under the provisions**
16 **of this Paragraph, within twenty-four hours prior to the attempted taking, shall**
17 **notify the sheriff of the parish in which the property is located of his intention**

1 **to attempt to take outlaw quadrupeds under the provisions of this Paragraph.**

DIGEST

Morrish (SB 660)

Proposed law authorizes the use of a helicopter on private property when taking outlaw quadrupeds any time of year during daylight hours.

Proposed law provides that any person attempting to take outlaw quadrupeds with a helicopter, must notify the sheriff of the parish in which the property is located within 24 hours of the attempted taking of the outlaw quadruped.

Effective August 1, 2014.
