HB No. 1218

Abstract: Requires that an insurer print on an automobile insurance identification card the coverages provided and the lack of uninsured motorist coverage, when applicable, and that an employer post a notice when there is no uninsured motorist coverage on a vehicle an employer provides to an employee

<u>Present law</u> requires an insurance card issued by an insurer as proof of motor vehicle liability insurance to contain the name and address of the insurance company, the policy number, a description of the motor vehicle, the effective date and expiration date of the policy, and the name of any excluded driver.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further requires that the insurance card contain the coverages provided by the policy and the lack of uninsured motorist coverage, when applicable.

<u>Proposed law</u> further requires an employer who provides a vehicle for employee use to post in a conspicuous place a notice that the vehicle does not have uninsured motorist coverage.
