2 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
3 urge and request the Department of Health and Hospitals to study the feasibility, desirability,
4 and practicality of alternative transportation sites (i.e. urgent care clinics) for patients who
5 access emergency medical services via the 911 system and the use of ambulance service
6 providers and suppliers to assist with training and management of this population.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health and Hospitals submit
8 its findings in a report to the Senate and House committees on health and welfare no later
9 than January 1, 2015.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
11 secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals.
