
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to Original Senate Bill No. 342 by Senator Donahue

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, between lines 20 and 21 insert the following:

3 **"(b) The governor shall appoint from the nominations at least four members**
4 **who are residents of the unincorporated areas of the district."**

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 2, line 21, change "(b)" to "(c)"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 3, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following:

9 **"(5) Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, no commissioner**
10 **whose term is expired shall be allowed to continue to serve or to vote.**

11 **(6) The governor or the nominating entity may remove a commissioner for**
12 **neglect of his duties, which shall include a violation of state law or public policy of the**
13 **state."**

14 AMENDMENT NO. 4

15 On page 3, line 24, after "purpose" insert "provided that any election shall be held only
16 **within the district"**

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 4, on line 25, after "undertaking" insert "**, provided that no action or work**
19 **undertaken by the district shall violate the master plan of the Coastal Protection and**
20 **Restoration Authority or any statewide drainage and flood control plan administered**
21 **by the Department of Transportation and Development"**

22 AMENDMENT NO. 6

23 On page 5, between lines 5 and 6, insert the following:

24 **"(3)Any contract or agreement entered into by the board shall comply with state**
25 **law and public policy of the state."**

26 AMENDMENT NO. 7

27 On page 5, between lines 18 and 19, insert the following:

28 **"H. No action or work undertaken by the board or contract or agreement**
29 **entered into by the board shall violate the master plan of the Coastal Protection and**
30 **Restoration Authority or any statewide drainage and flood control plan administered**
31 **by the Department of Transportation and Development."**
