3	WHEREAS, March of Dimes was founded in 1938 by President Franklin D.
4	Roosevelt and supported the development of the polio vaccine that eradicated the disease
5	from the United States of America; and
6	WHEREAS, the same polio vaccine continues to protect babies today; through the
7	support of March of Dimes, there has not been a single outbreak of polio in our country in
8	more than thirty years; and
9	WHEREAS, in Louisiana over 62,000 babies are born each year and 9,400 of those
10	babies are born prematurely and March of Dimes has helped each and every one of those
11	babies through its research, education, vaccines, and breakthroughs; and
12	WHEREAS, on Tuesday, April 8, 2014, March of Dimes volunteers and staff from
13	across the state are visiting the Louisiana State Capitol to raise awareness of the serious need
14	to protect Louisiana babies and to advocate for policies that improve the quality of care for
15	Louisiana moms and babies.
