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**HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by Representative Moreno to Engrossed House Bill No. 754 by Representative Moreno

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "prescribing" and before "of " insert "and administering of an opioid  
3 antagonist for overdoses"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 5, after "responder;" and before "and to provide" insert "to require training  
6 prior to receiving a prescription for naloxone; to require promulgation of best practices;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:

9 "C.(1) Before receiving a prescription for naloxone or  
10 another opioid antagonist pursuant to this Section, a first responder  
11 shall complete the training necessary to safely and properly  
12 administer naloxone or another opioid antagonist to individuals who  
13 are undergoing or who are believed to be undergoing an  
14 opioid-related drug overdose. The training, at a minimum, shall  
15 cover all of the following:

16 (a) Techniques on how to recognize symptoms of an opioid-  
17 related overdose.

18 (b) Standards and procedures for the storage and  
19 administration of naloxone or another opioid antagonist.

20 (c) Emergency follow-up procedures."

21 AMENDMENT NO. 4

22 On page 2, at the beginning of line 10, change "C." to "(2)"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 5

24 On page 2, after line 27, insert the following:

25 "F. The deputy secretary of public safety services of the  
26 Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall develop and  
27 promulgate, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act, a  
28 set of best practices for use by a fire department or law enforcement  
29 agency in the administration and enforcement of this Section  
30 including but not limited to the training necessary to safely and  
31 properly administer naloxone or another opioid antagonist to  
32 individuals who are undergoing or who are believed to be undergoing  
33 an opioid-related drug overdose, the standards and procedures for the  
34 storage and administration of naloxone or another opioid antagonist,  
35 and emergency follow-up procedures."
