Provides relative to civil jury trial threshold. (gov sig)

<u>Present law</u> provides that a trial by jury shall not be available in certain matters, including a suit where the amount of no individual petitioner's cause of action exceeds \$50,000 exclusive of interest and costs, except for certain cases.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes "\$50,000" to "that amount in controversy set forth in 28 U.S.C. 1332(a)" and retains remainder of present law. 28 U.S.C. 1332(a) provides that the district courts shall have original jurisdiction of all civil actions where the matter in controversy exceeds the sum or value of \$75,000, exclusive of interest and costs.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation would result in a decreased workload for district and city courts as a result of increasing the civil jury threshold amount. It is anticipated that the number of civil jury trials will decrease due to increasing the civil jury threshold amount. However, it is unknown how much the workload for district courts and city courts would decrease.

The number of persons who seek a civil jury trial may decrease since the threshold amount increases by \$25,000 (\$75,000 proposed - \$50,000 current), therefore the number cilvil jury trials held may decrease. The costs associated with civil jury trials include summoning jurors, compensation for court attendance (\$25 per person per day), reimbursement for mileage (\$0.16 per mile), and expenses of the jury commission, clerk of court, and sheriff. This cost is paid by the party that seeks a jury trial and is paid to the clerk of court in either a cash deposit or a jury bond.

It should be noted that to the extent a judge waives the jury trial security deposit or expenses exceed the deposit amount, the costs associated with the jury will be paid by the judicial expense fund of the district court or the parish treasury in districts that do not have a judicial expense fund.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation would result in a decrease in local fund revenues as a result of increasing the civil jury threshold amount. The number of persons who seek a civil jury trial may decrease since the threshold amount increases by \$25,000 (\$75,000 proposed - \$50,000 current), therefore the number of cash deposits and jury bonds received by the clerk of court may decrease. The deposits will be used to pay costs associated with jury trials and in the event funds remain from the deposits, the funds will be refunded by the clerk of court to the party filing the cash deposit.
