DIGEST

White (SB 313)

Present law defines and provides penalties for the crime of home invasion.

Present law provides that whoever commits the crime of home invasion armed with a dangerous weapon is to be fined up to \$7,000 and imprisoned at hard labor for up to 30 years.

Proposed law retains present law and adds that whoever commits the crime of home invasion armed with a dangerous weapon is to be imprisoned for a minimum of five years. Proposed law otherwise retains present law.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

1. Deletes changes to penalties for home invasion when not armed with a dangerous weapon from proposed law.
