AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 5, after "exceptions; and before "and" insert "to provide with respect to tipped employees; to provide for the increased cost to Medicaid providers due to a higher minimum wage;"

- 7 On page 2, line 14, change "<u>B.</u>" to "<u>C.</u>"
- 8 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- 9 On page 2, between lines 19 and 20, insert the following:

(1) Upon each minimum wage increase, the Department of Health and 11 Hospitals shall adjust the rates paid to Medicaid providers to reflect the increased cost of providing services to Medicaid recipients as a result of the increased 12 13 minimum wage. 14 (2) In the event that the services to Medicaid recipients are provided through 15 a managed care contract, the Department of Health and Hospitals shall make the necessary adjustments in payments to the managed care contractor to assure that 16 rates paid to service providers are sufficient to enable the provider to pay an 17
