Proposed law provides for the payment of certain costs, including court costs, attorneys fees and expert witness costs and fees regarding the following civil matters: signing of pleadings, peremptory exception, ex parte, motion to strike, motion for judgment on pleadings, affidavits, affirmative defenses, and alternative defenses.

Proposed law requires district courts to maintain records of awards of attorney fees and court costs and report such records to the judicial administrator of the Supreme Court.
