2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:2345(B), relative to municipal chiefs of police; to provide for
3	training requirements for each municipal chief of police; to change the training hours
4	required relative to continuing education; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 33:2345(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§2345. Training

9	B. Beginning January 1, $\frac{2004}{2015}$, each municipal chief of police shall be
10	required to complete twenty-four twelve hours of continuing education as approved
11	by the board within every twenty-four-month period calendar year.

Abstract: Provides for training requirements for each municipal chief of police.

<u>Present law</u> requires each municipal chief of police to complete 24 hours of continuing education approved by the board within every 24-month period, beginning Jan. 1, 2004.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> except it changes the hours of continuing education required from 24 hours in a 24-month period to 12 hours in every calendar year, beginning Jan. 1, 2015.
