1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 8, change "an affiliated" to "a"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 9, change "may" to "shall" and after "between" delete "the affiliated  
5 organization," and insert in lieu thereof "one business organization and another"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 1, line 10, delete "juridical"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, line 11, after "organization" and before "as" delete the comma " , "

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 1, between lines 11 and 12, insert the following:

13 "B. The separate juridical personalities of business organizations may not be  
14 disregarded merely because:

15 (1) They control one another or are under the common control of the same  
16 person.

17 (2) They have common directors, officers, members, managers, partners, or  
18 employees.

19 (3) They have common offices.

20 (4) They are subject to unified administrative control.

21 (5) They utilize a centralized accounting system.

22 (6) One organization finances, incorporates, or organizes another.

23 (7) One organization makes properly-documented payments on behalf of  
24 another or makes properly-documented use of the property of another.

25 (8) The employees of one organization provide properly-documented  
26 services for another.

27 (9) One organization receives no business other than that given to it by  
28 another."

30 On page 1, line 12, change "B." to "C."

31 AMENDMENT NO. 7

32 On page 1, after line 16, insert the following:

33 "D. This Section shall not affect any law or administrative rule that permits  
34 or requires a group of business organizations to be consolidated, unified, or  
35 disregarded for the purposes provided in such law or administrative rule."
