KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT. Provides for licensing and regulation of manufacturers, dealer-distributors, users, blasters, and handlers of explosives. (gov sig)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

- 1. Clarifies that the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections can inspect all facilities under the control of an explosives licensee.
- 2. Makes technical corrections.
- 3. Adds emergency effective date.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

Thompson (SB 129)

<u>Present law</u> provides for the licensing and regulation of manufacturers, dealer-distributors, users, blasters, and handlers of explosives by the deputy secretary for public safety services of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but adds provision that authorizes the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to inspect all facilities under the control of an explosives licensee when the license is issued pursuant to state law.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires, that in addition to compliance with state law, each manufacturer, dealer-distributor, and user of explosives also possess a valid explosives license or permit from the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
